

PRAY WITHOUT CEASING

4 IDEAS TO HELP YOUR CHURCH PRAY FOR ONE ANOTHER

1 Share an opt-in prayer directory with your members.

Ask members who want to be prayed for by other members if their contact info can be shared. Create a vCard for everyone who opts in and share these with members who want to pray. These will get added to their address books, which syncs with Ceaseless so those members will be surfaced as people to pray for.

2 Each Sunday, invite members to meet 2 new people at church and add them to Ceaseless.

After four Sundays, everyone will have eight new people to pray for from your local church and everyone who comes to your worship service will eventually be prayed for by someone else from your church.

3 Invite small groups to pray for each other throughout the week with Ceaseless.

Ask everyone in a small group to add each other's contact information to their phones. Small group members can favorite all the other members of their group in Ceaseless so they show up to be prayed for more regularly.

4 Take time in prayer meetings to pray for the people who showed up on Ceaseless together.

If your church already has a prayer meeting, leverage Ceaseless by inviting people to pray together for the names that they got on that day. This helps people persevere in prayer and encourages them to reach out and serve the people they are reminded of.
